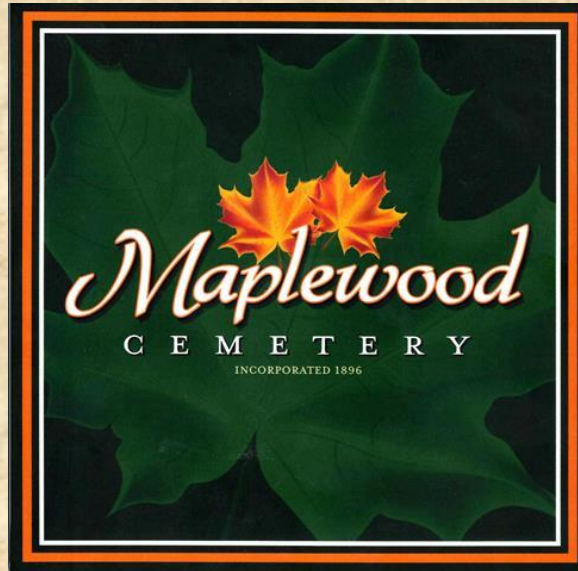
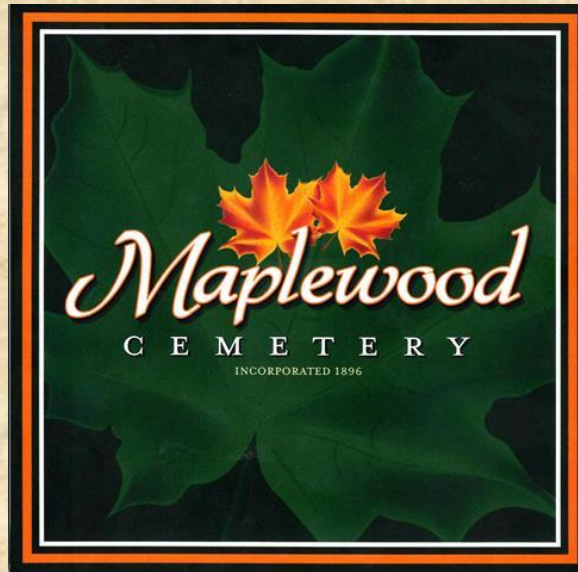


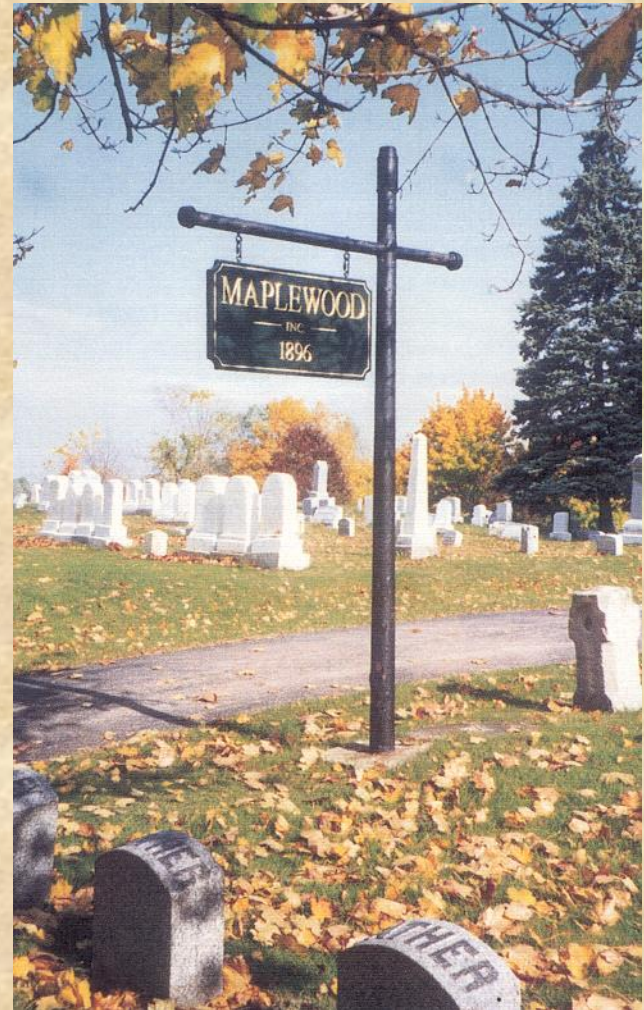

About Us....



- **Maplewood Cemetery** is owned and operated by the **Maplewood Cemetery Association** which was incorporated in 1896 as a NY Cemetery Corporation.
- **Maplewood Cemetery is a not-for-profit, volunteer run, charitable organization made up of member-owners elected to the Association Board of Directors.** The Board of Directors manages the cemetery corporation, appoints a superintendent, elects Officers for various functions and positions to make sure the cemetery grounds and business is properly operated, maintained and meets all of the required NY state and Federal regulations for cemeteries and non-profit corporations.
- **Maplewood Cemetery Association is closely regulated, audited and inspected by the N.Y.S. Division of Cemeteries and operates in the public interest rather than as a profit-making venture.**
- **Maplewood Cemetery** is also a member of the **N.Y. State Association of Cemeteries** which is dedicated to the furtherance of effective cemetery management and operation for better community service.





CEMETERY REGULATION IN NEW YORK STATE

New York is the most populous of the six states (including, Connecticut, Massachusetts, Maine, New Jersey, and Wyoming) in which **cemeteries are required to be operated only on a non-profit basis**. New York State's historical not for profit cemetery structure "***for the mutual benefit of plot owners therein***" is based upon the following aims:

- to protect the well-being of its citizens;**
- to promote the public welfare;**
- to prevent cemeteries from falling into disrepair and dilapidation; and**
- to prevent cemeteries from becoming a burden upon the community. "for the mutual benefit of plot owners therein."** Not-for-Profit Corporation Law (N-PCL) §1501.

In 1847 New York passed its first general law "authorizing the incorporation of rural cemetery associations." Over the next 100 years, many provisions were added relative to cemetery associations or corporations, resulting in the Membership Corporations Law (MCL) Article 9 (sections 70-105). This portion of the MCL was repealed and replaced with no change in form or substance by N-PCL §1401, effective in 1970. In 1977 N-PCL §1401, with all its myriad subdivisions, was enacted into current N-PCL Article 15 (sections 1501-1515).

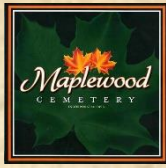
The New York State Cemetery Board was created by statute in 1949 following a 1949 Report of the Attorney General, which was a study of operations and financial activities harmful to cemeteries.



The **Division of Cemeteries** and the **New York State Cemetery Board** regulate only those cemeteries that are incorporated under the **Not-for-Profit Corporation Law**. Cemeteries that do not fall under our jurisdiction include religious, municipal, private, national and family cemeteries.

The **Cemetery Board** oversees the **Division of Cemeteries'** operations and administers the New York State Cemetery Law. The Cemetery Law sets standards for the establishment, maintenance, and preservation of burial grounds in New York State.

The Cemetery Board is made up of the New York State Secretary of State, the New York State Attorney General and the New York State Commissioner of Health.

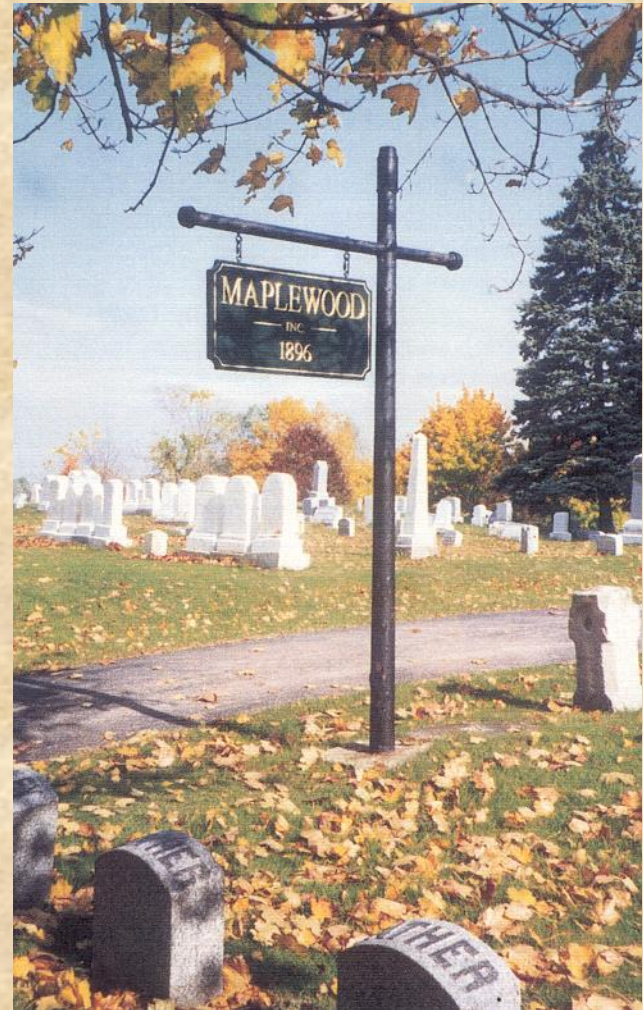

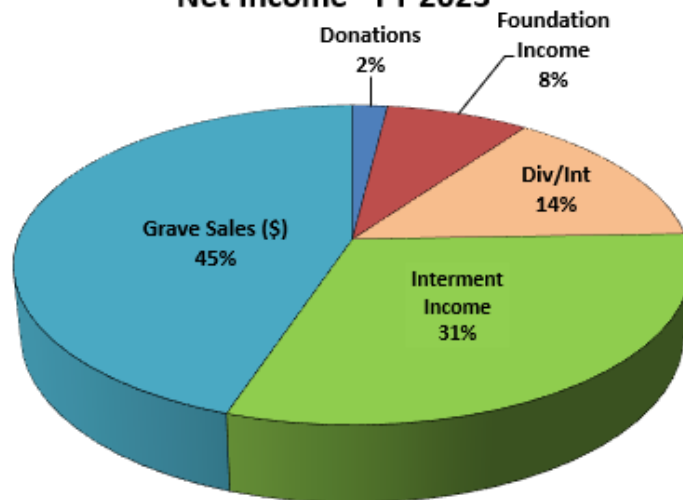

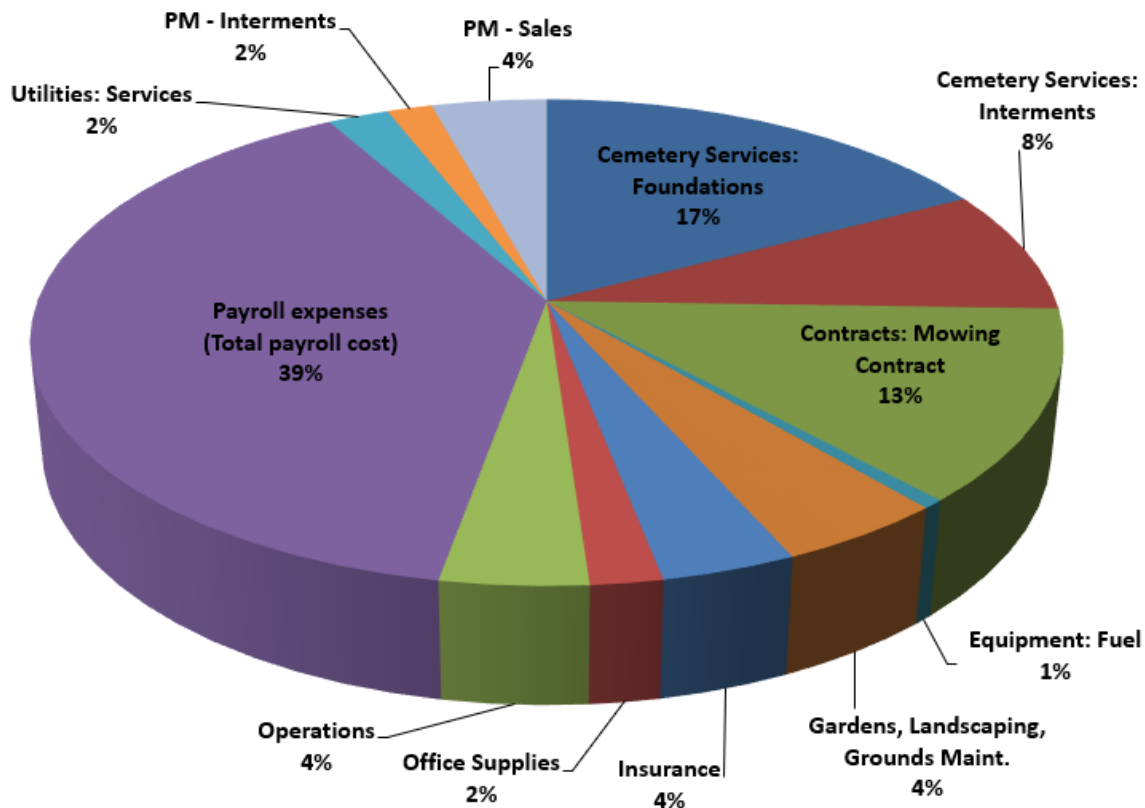
Net Income - FY 2023

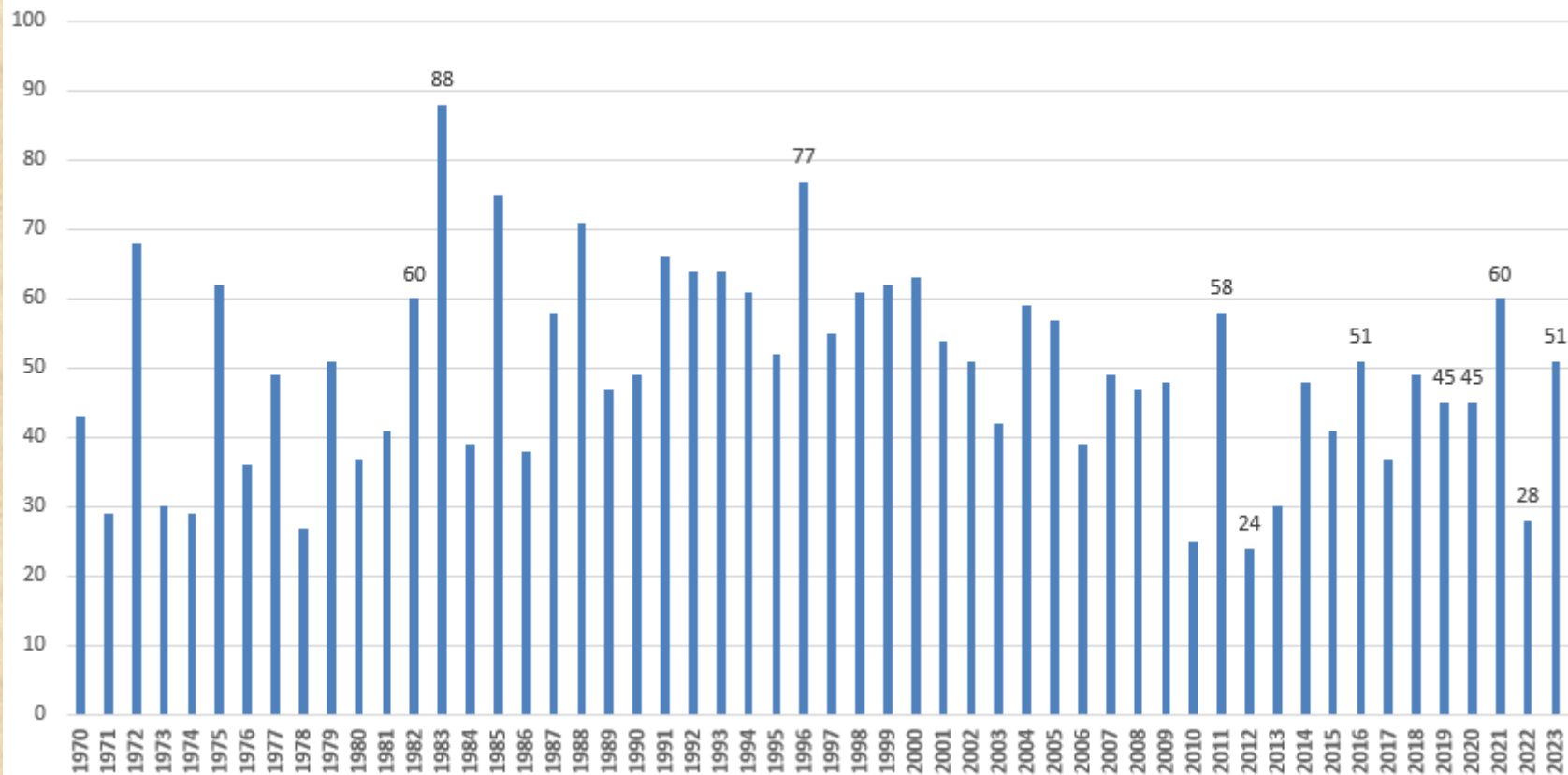

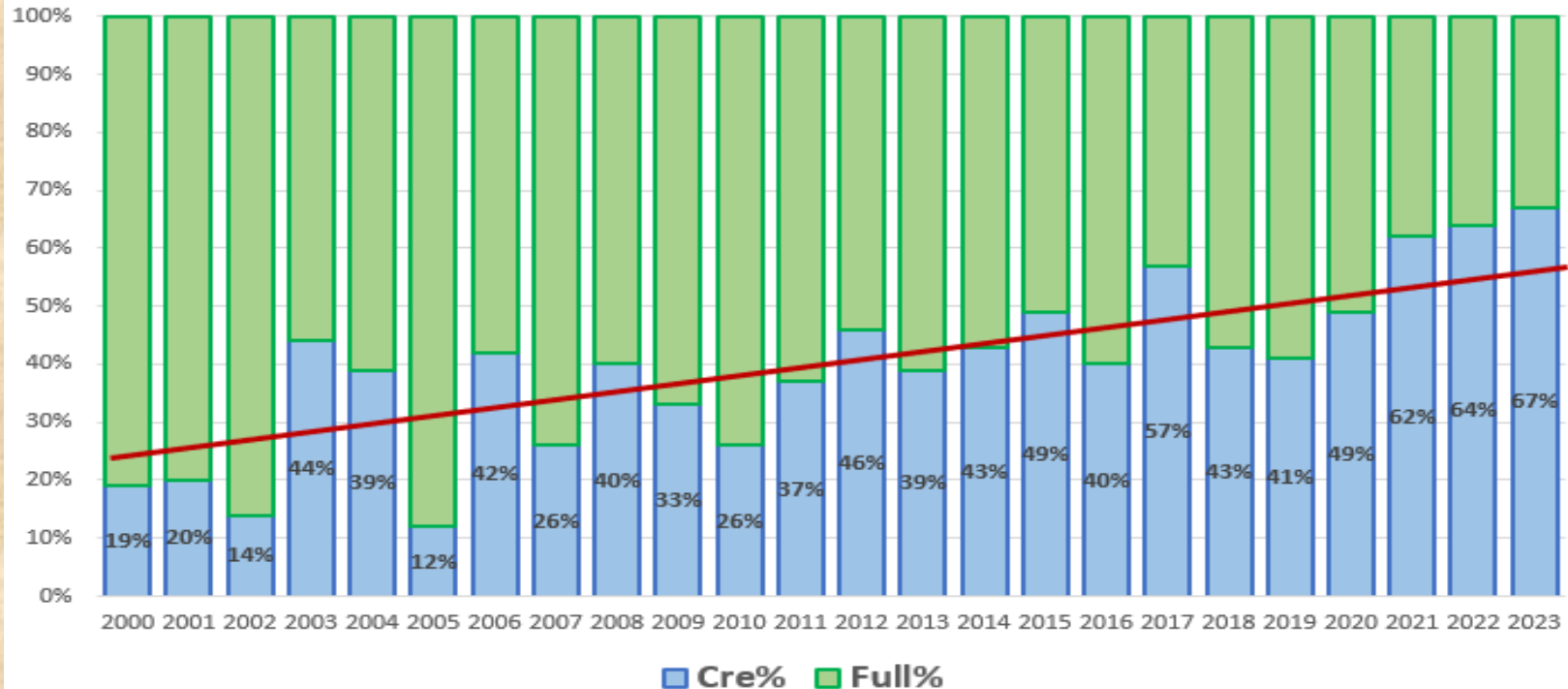

Maplewood Cemetery: Full vs. Cremation Interments



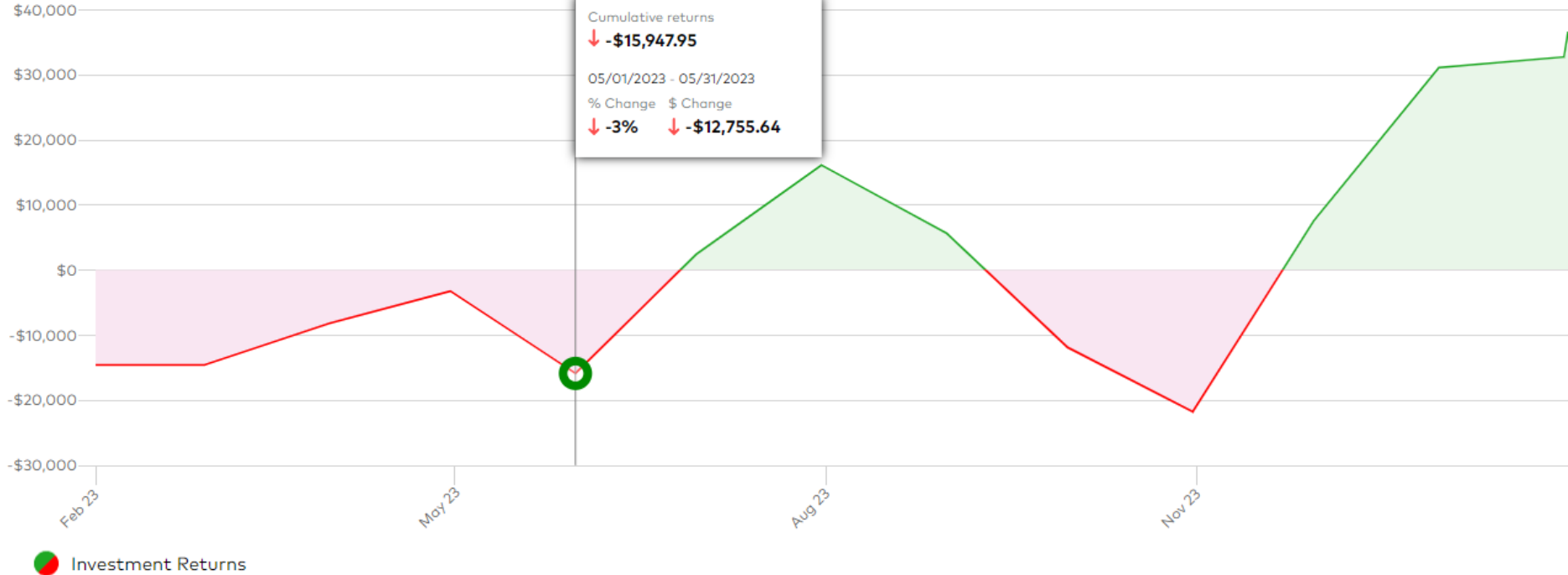
U.S. Cremation Rate Expected to Top 80% by 2045
